New Parish Electoral Roll – don't forget to sign up

The parish electoral roll is a list of all those entitled to vote in elections related to a particular parish in the Church of England. Those enrolled are entitled to vote at our Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) and also be nominated to stand for election onto the our Parochial Church Council (PCC). This is the formal governing body of the church and also the board of trustees of the church as a charity. This year the electoral roll is completely renewed so everybody who wishes to be on the roll (even if you have been on the previous one) must apply to be enrolled. To enrol you must be 16 years of age or more and reside in the parish or if not residing in the parish be regular worshippers (at least 6 months) at Holy Trinity.
